An act relating to public records; amending s. 119.07, F.S.; prohibiting certain law enforcement officers from accepting or processing public records requests; providing requirements for such officers; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

## Section 1. Subsection (10) is added to section 119.07, Florida Statutes, to read:

119.07 Inspection and copying of records; photographing public records; fees; exemptions.—

- (10) (a) A law enforcement officer, as defined in s.

  943.10(1), who is actively engaged in the performance of an official duty, including, but not limited to, a call for service, an investigation, a case-related activity, or any other official police activity, may not accept or process a public records request at such time.
- (b) The determination of whether an officer is actively engaged in the performance of an official duty under this subsection shall be made by the officer. Upon such determination, the officer shall verbally inform the requestor that the request cannot be accepted or processed and shall direct the requestor to:
