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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to electronic signatures associated
with total loss vehicles and vessels; amending s.
319.30, F.S.; requiring insurance companies to
implement certain control processes and procedures for
certain electronic signatures; deleting a requirement
that electronic signatures on odometer disclosures
submitted through insurance companies be executed in a
specified manner; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section
319.30, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

319.30 Definitions; dismantling, destruction, change of
identity of motor vehicle, vessel, or mobile home; salvage.—

(3)

(d) An electronic signature that is consistent with chapter
668 satisfies any signature required under this subsection.
However, insurance companies must implement control processes
and procedures acceptable to the department to ensure adequate
identity verification and preservation, disposition, integrity,
security, confidentiality, and auditability of electronic
signatures, ~~except that an electronic signature on an odometer~~
~~disclosure submitted through an insurance company must be~~
~~executed using an electronic signature, as defined in s.~~
~~668.003(4), which uses a system providing an Identity Assurance~~
~~Level, Authenticator Assurance Level, and Federation Assurance~~
~~Level, as described in the National Institute of Standards and~~

~~Technology Special Publication 800-63-3, as of December 1, 2017,~~
~~which are equivalent to or greater than Level 2, for each level,~~

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
