Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (10) of section 501.2041, Florida Statutes, is amended, and paragraph (a) of that subsection is republished, to read:

- 501.2041 Unlawful acts and practices by social media
- (10)(a) All information received by the department pursuant to an investigation by the department or a law enforcement agency of a violation of this section is confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution until such time as the investigation is completed or ceases to be active. This exemption shall be construed in conformity with s. 119.071(2)(c).
- (e) This subsection is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2031 <del>2026</del>, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.
