14 scheduled repeal date of the exemption; providing an
15 effective date.

19 **Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (8) of section**
20 **287.137, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

21 287.137 Antitrust violations; denial or revocation of the
22 right to transact business with public entities; denial of
23 economic benefits.—

26 Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand
27 repealed on October 2, 2031 ~~2026~~, unless reviewed and saved from
28 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

30 **501.2041, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

31 501.2041 Unlawful acts and practices by social media

34 (e) This subsection is subject to the Open Government
35 Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand
36 repealed on October 2, 2031 ~~2026~~, unless reviewed and saved from
