(2) A defendant who is engaged in substantial and not isolated activity within this state, whether such activity is wholly interstate, intrastate, or otherwise, is subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of this state, regardless of whether or not the claim arises from that activity. Such activity includes, but is not limited to, a request by a defendant, regardless of his or her location, to a resident of this state to transfer virtual currency as defined in s. 560.103 to an account located outside of this state.
