A bill to be entitled

An act relating to electric vehicle registration fees; amending s. 320.08001, F.S.; defining the term "battery electric vehicle"; requiring the owner of a battery electric vehicle to pay certain annual registration fees; requiring that such fees be deposited into the State Transportation Trust Fund and used for a certain purpose; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 320.08001, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

320.08001 Electric vehicles; license tax; fee.-

- (1) The license tax for an electric vehicle or low-speed vehicle is the same as that prescribed in s. 320.08 for a vehicle that is not electrically powered.
- (2) (a) For purposes of this subsection, the term "battery electric vehicle" means a motor vehicle powered solely by an electric motor drawing current from rechargeable batteries and which is not equipped with an internal combustion engine.
- (b) In addition to the license tax imposed under subsection (1) and any other fee imposed under this chapter, the owner of a battery electric vehicle registered in this state must pay an annual fee of \$250 at the time of initial registration and each renewal thereafter.
- (c) Fees collected under this subsection must be deposited into the State Transportation Trust Fund and used for the
