**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. **Paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section 112.1816, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

112.1816 Firefighters; cancer diagnosis.—  
(4)

(c) Firefighters who die as a result of cancer or circumstances that arise out of the treatment of cancer are considered to have died in the manner as described in s. 112.191(2)(a), and all of the benefits arising out of such death are available to the deceased firefighter's beneficiary. Such death benefits must be made available by the former employer of the firefighter for 1 year after the date on which the

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17 firefighter terminated employment so long as the firefighter  
18 otherwise met the criteria specified in this subsection when he  
19 or she terminated employment and was not employed as a  
20 firefighter after that date.

21 **Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
