reflective matter, illuminated device, spray, coating, covering, or other material onto or around any license plate which interferes with the legibility, angular visibility, or detectability of the primary features or details, including the license plate number or validation sticker, any feature or detail on the license plate or interferes with the ability to record the primary features or details, including the license plate number or validation sticker, any feature or detail on the license plate. A plate frame that impinges upon information located on the top or bottom of the license plate is permissible, as long as law enforcement can identify the state issuing the license plate. A person who knowingly violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
