7 (a) Subsections (2)-(6) ~~(2)-(5)~~ do not limit or restrict
8 the department or the supervisor in his or her duty to act upon
9 direct receipt of, access to, or knowledge of information from
10 any governmental entity that identifies a registered voter as
11 potentially ineligible. If the department or supervisor receives
12 information from any governmental entity other than those
13 identified in subsections (2)-(6) ~~(2)-(5)~~ that a registered

14 voter is ineligible because the voter is deceased, adjudicated a
 15 convicted felon without having had his or her voting rights
 16 restored, adjudicated mentally incapacitated without having had
 17 his or her voting rights restored, does not meet the age
 18 requirement pursuant to s. 97.041, is not a United States
 19 citizen, is a fictitious person, or has listed an address that
 20 is not his or her address of legal residence, the supervisor
 21 must adhere to the procedures set forth in subsection (8) ~~(7)~~
 22 before the removal of the name of a registered voter who is
 23 determined to be ineligible from the statewide voter
 24 registration system.

25 (b) A registered voter may not be identified as ineligible
 26 or potentially ineligible based on information derived from or
 27 generated by generative artificial intelligence, automated
 28 decisionmaking systems, algorithmic processes, or private third-
 29 party data sources. This section does not prohibit the use of
 30 technology to assist in record maintenance, provided that a
 31 voter may not be designated as ineligible or potentially
 32 ineligible without independent human review and corroboration
 33 from official government sources.
