Between lines 246 and 247, insert:

Section 9. (1) If a joint resolution proposing an amendment or a revision to ss. 4, 6, and 9, Article VII of the State Constitution is to be submitted to the electors at the November 2026 general election, the Department of Revenue shall, within 10 days after the effective date of this act, provide a publicly accessible website for informing electors of the local programs and institutions that will be impacted or eliminated if the amendment is approved.
