**Point-of-sale Terminals;** Authorizing the Department of the Lottery to create a program that authorizes certain persons to purchase a ticket or game at a point-of-sale terminal; authorizing the department, a retailer operating from one or more locations, or a vendor approved by the department to use a point-of-sale terminal to sell a lottery ticket or game; prohibiting a point-of-sale terminal from being used to redeem a winning ticket, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

**SB 460 (2R) by Senator Bradley and others—**

**Experimental Treatments for Terminal Conditions;** Revising the definition of the term “investigational drug, biological product, or device”; providing for eligible patients or their legal representatives to purchase and possess cannabis for medical use; authorizing certain licensed dispensing organizations to manufacture, possess, sell, deliver, distribute, dispense, and dispose of cannabis; exempting such organizations from specified laws, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**SB 498 (2R) by Senator Sobel and others—**

**Repeal of a Prohibition on Cohabitation;** Deleting provisions prohibiting cohabitation by unmarried men and women, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

**CS/SB 504 (2R) by the Committee on Health Policy and Senator Grimsley—**

**Laser Hair Removal;** Providing certification and training requirements for licensed electrologists who use laser or pulsed-light devices in hair removal, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program;** Providing that the initial award period and the renewal period for students who are unable to accept an initial award immediately after completion of high school due to a full-time religious or service obligation begin upon the completion of the religious or service obligation; requiring a student, as a prerequisite for the Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars award, to identify a civic issue or a professional area of interest and develop a plan for his or her personal involvement in addressing the issue or learning about the area, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**Public Corruption;** Revising the definition of the term “bribery”; revising requirements for prosecution; revising the prohibition against unlawful compensation or reward for official behavior to conform to changes made by the act; revising the prohibition against official misconduct to conform to changes made by the act; revising applicability of the offense to include public contractors, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2016

**Drones;** Declaring that a drone is a dangerous instrumentality; providing applicability, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**Department of Transportation;** Increasing the minimum amount that must be made available annually from the State Transportation Trust Fund to fund the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Program; authorizing the department to enter into certain agreements related to the federal surface transportation project delivery program under certain federal law; authorizing the department’s Pinellas Bayway System to be transferred by the department and become part of the turnpike system under the Florida Turnpike Enterprise Law; creating a nonprofit corporation to be known as the “Florida Department of Transportation Financing Corporation”, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**Firesafety;** Revising provisions relating to certain structures located on agricultural property which are exempt from the Florida Fire Prevention Code; requiring that certain structures used for agritourism activity be classified; providing that such classifications are subject to annual inspection; authorizing a local fire official to consider a specified publication when identifying an alternative to a firesafety code, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**SB 908 (2R) by Senator Lee—**

**Title Insurance;** Revising the reserves that certain title insurers must set aside after a certain date; revising premium reserve requirements and calculations for a title insurer who transfers domicile to this state, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**Family Law;** Citing this act as the “Collaborative Law Process Act”; providing that a collaborative law process begins when the parties enter into a collaborative law participation agreement; prohibiting a tribunal from ordering a party to participate in a collaborative law process over the party’s objection; providing for confidentiality of communications made during the collaborative law process, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2016

**SB 996 (2R) by Senator Negron—**

**Civil Remedies for Terrorism;** Creating a cause of action for acts relating to terrorism; specifying a measure of damages; prohibiting claims by specified individuals; providing for attorney fees and costs, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**SB 2506 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations (Lee)—**

**Compensation for Representation;** Revising compensation amounts for representation in a criminal proceeding, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

**SB 7028 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Ring)—**

**State Board of Administration;** Redefining the term “public fund”; requiring the board, rather than the public fund, to maintain a list of certain scrutinized companies rather than assembling the list by a certain time; deleting a condition that may no longer be used by the board in scrutinizing companies, relating to a specified declaration, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016

*Recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on General Government; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

**CS/SB 7034 (2R) by the Committees on Appropriations, and Children, Families, and Elder Affairs (Sobel)—**

**Prenatal Services and Early Childhood Development;** Revising the requirements for the Department of Health to maintain a clearinghouse of information for parents and health care providers and to increase public awareness on developmental evaluation and early intervention programs; renaming the “Infants and Toddlers Early Intervention Program” as the “Early Steps Program”; requiring the development of an individualized family support plan for each child served in the program, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2016
