## BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

### BILLS ON THIRD READING

#### **SB 2500, 1st Eng. (3R) by the Committee on Appropriations (Bradley)—**

**Appropriations;** Providing moneys for the annual period beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, and supplemental appropriations for the period ending June 30, 2020, to pay salaries, and other expenses, capital outlay - buildings, and other improvements, and for other specified purposes of the various agencies of state government, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise provided herein, this act shall take effect July 1, 2020, or upon becoming law, whichever occurs later; however, if this act becomes law after July 1, 2020, then it shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2020

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#### **SB 2502, 1st Eng. (3R) by the Committee on Appropriations (Bradley)—**

**Implementing the 2020-2021 General Appropriations Act;** Incorporating by reference certain calculations of the Florida Education Finance Program; suspending the Florida Best and Brightest Teacher and Principal Allocation for the 2020-2021 fiscal year; creating the Teacher Salary Increase Allocation; specifying the source of charter school capital outlay funding; establishing the Florida Institute of Politics at the Florida State University; extending for 1 fiscal year a provision requiring the Agency for Health Care Administration to make payments to Medicaid-covered services, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2020; or, if this act fails to become a law until after that date, it shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to July 1, 2020

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#### **SB 2504 (3R) by the Committee on Appropriations (Bradley)—**

**State Employees;** Providing for the resolution of collective bargaining issues at impasse between the state and certified bargaining units of state employees, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Read the second time on February 12, 2020*

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#### **SB 7044 (3R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Hooper)—**

**State-administered Retirement Systems;** Revising required employer retirement contribution rates for each membership class and subclass of the Florida Retirement System; providing a declaration of important state interest, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Read the second time on February 12, 2020*

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#### **SB 348 (3R) by Senator Bean and others—**

**Florida Kidcare Program;** Removing the lifetime maximum cap on covered expenses for a child enrolled in the Florida Healthy Kids program, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Read the second time on February 12, 2020*

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#### **SB 362 (3R) by Senator Hooper and others—**

**Florida Tourism Marketing;** Revising the scheduled repeal of the Florida Tourism Industry Marketing Corporation direct-support organization; abrogating the scheduled repeal of the Division of Tourism Marketing of Enterprise Florida, Inc., etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Read the second time on February 12, 2020*

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**CS/HB 177 (3R) by the Committee on Health Care Appropriations Subcommittee, Representatives Yarborough, Duran and others—**

**Prescription Drug Donation Repository Program;** Creates Prescription Drug Donation Repository Program within DOH; provides criteria & conditions for donation of prescription drugs & supplies from certain authorized entities for dispensing to eligible patients; authorizes Governor to waive program patient eligibility requirements during declared state of emergency. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Substituted for CS/SB 58(SUB) (Book) and read the second time on February 12, 2020*

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**SB 7004 (3R) by the Committee on Finance and Tax (Gainer)—**

**OGSR/Taxpayer E-mail Addresses Held by a Tax Collector;** Amending a provision relating to an exemption from public records requirements for taxpayer e-mail addresses held by a tax collector for certain purposes; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2020

*Read the second time on February 12, 2020*

**SPECIAL ORDER CALENDAR FOR THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2020**

**CS/SB 226 (SO) by the Committee on Health Policy and Senator Harrell—**

**Athletic Trainers;** Revising the definition of the term “athletic trainer”; requiring certain licensees to maintain certification in good standing without lapse as a condition of renewal of their athletic trainer licenses; requiring that an athletic trainer work within a specified scope of practice; requiring the direct supervision of an athletic training student to be in accordance with rules adopted by the Board of Athletic Training, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Health Policy; the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

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**CS/SB 292 (SO) by the Committee on Banking and Insurance and Senator Broxson—**

**Insurance Claims Data;** Defining the terms “loss run statement” and “provide”; requiring surplus lines and authorized insurers, respectively, to provide insureds either a loss run statement or certain information within a certain timeframe after receipt of the insured’s written request; requiring insurers to provide notice to the agent of record after providing a loss run statement; prohibiting insurers from charging a fee to prepare and provide one loss run statement annually, etc. Effective Date: 01/01/2021

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; the Committee on Commerce and Tourism reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/CS/SB 580 (SO) by the Committees on Community Affairs, Judiciary, Senator Bracy and others—**

**Uniform Partition of Heirs Property Act;** Creating the "Uniform Partition of Heirs Property Act"; providing requirements relating to the court determination of heirs property; providing for the determination of property value; providing for buyout of cotenants; providing for sale of property through open-market sale, sealed bids, or auction; authorizing certain cotenants to agree to certain partitions of real property, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

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**CS/SB 372 (SO) by the Committee on Education, Senator Lee and others—**

**Postsecondary Education for Certain Military Personnel;** Requiring the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education, in consultation with the Department of Veterans’ Affairs, to create a process for the uniform award of postsecondary credit or career education clock hours to certain servicemembers and veterans of the United States Armed Forces; requiring certain postsecondary institutions to award uniform postsecondary credit or career education clock hours for specified courses taken and occupations held by individuals during their service in the military, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs and Space; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

**SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING**

**SB 88 (2R) by Senator Stewart and others—**

**Child Care Facilities;** Citing this act at the "Child Safety Alarm Act"; requiring that, by a specified date, vehicles used by child care facilities and large family child care homes to transport children be equipped with a reliable alarm system that prompts the driver to inspect the vehicle for children before exiting the vehicle; requiring the Department of Children and Families to adopt by rule minimum safety standards for such systems and to maintain a list of approved alarm manufacturers and alarm systems, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; reported favorably by the Committee on Infrastructure and Security; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**CS/SB 100 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations, Senator Harrell and others—**

**Dispensing Medicinal Drugs;** Authorizing certain hospitals to dispense supplies of prescribed medicinal drugs in a specified amount to emergency department patients or inpatients upon discharge under certain circumstances; authorizing a greater specified supply of medicinal drugs to be prescribed and dispensed in areas in which a state of emergency has been declared and is in effect; authorizing a prescriber to provide a patient with a prescription for medicinal drugs beyond the initial prescription period under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Health Policy; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

**CS/SB 128 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Wright—**

**Public Records/Judicial Assistants;** Providing an exemption from public records requirements for certain identifying and location information of current and former judicial assistants and their spouses and children; providing for retroactive application of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/SB 136 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations, Senator Bean and others—**

**Adoption Benefits;** Revising the definition of the term “qualifying adoptive employee” and providing for retroactive application; providing that adoptive servicemembers and veterans are eligible to receive certain monetary benefits; requiring servicemembers and veterans seeking a benefit to apply to the Department of Children and Families, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; recommended favorably as a committee substitute by Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

**CS/CS/CS/SB 140 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Banking and Insurance, Community Affairs, Senator Hutson and others—**

**Fireworks;** Defining the term “designated holiday”; providing an exemption for the use of fireworks solely and exclusively during a designated holiday, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules*

**SJR 142 (2R) by Senator Brandes and others—**

**Abolishing the Constitution Revision Commission;** Proposing amendments to the State Constitution to abolish the Constitution Revision Commission, etc.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**CS/SB 154 (2R) by the Committee on Education, Senator Thurston and others—**

**Human Trafficking Education in Schools;** Revising the required health education in public schools to include information regarding the dangers and signs of human trafficking; specifying the minimum requirements of the human trafficking education portion of the comprehensive health education curriculum, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education; the Committee on Criminal Justice reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/SB 246 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Hooper—**

**Public Construction;** Revising the amount of retainage that certain local governmental entities and contractors may withhold from progress payments for any construction services contract; revising the amounts of retainage that certain public entities and contractors may withhold from progress payments for any construction services contract, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; the Committee on Community Affairs reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably*

**SB 248 (2R) by Senator Hooper—**

**Public Records/County Attorneys and Assistant County Attorneys;** Providing an exemption from public records requirements for the personal identifying and location information of current and former county attorneys and assistant county attorneys and the names and personal identifying and location information of the spouses and children of such attorneys; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 294 (2R) by Senator Wright and others—**

**Crimes Against Veterans;** Citing this act as the “Florida Veterans Protection Act”; providing an enhanced sentence for any person who commits aggravated white collar crimes against a certain number of veterans by obtaining or attempting to obtain a specified amount of money; providing criminal penalties, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs and Space; reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**CS/SB 326 (2R) by the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources and Senator Perry—**

**Environmental Regulation;** Specifying requirements for contracts between residential recycling collectors or recovered materials processing facilities and counties or municipalities for the collection or processing of residential recycling material; providing that a residential recycling collector or recovered materials processing facility is not required to collect, transport, or process contaminated recyclable material except pursuant to specified contractual requirements after a contract is executed; prohibiting local governments from requiring further verification from the Department of Environmental Protection for certain projects, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources; the Committee on Community Affairs reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/CS/SB 346 (2R) by the Committees on Appropriations, Criminal Justice, Senator Bradley and others—**

**Criminal Justice;** Prohibiting the imprisonment for longer than a certain time for persons who possess, purchase, or possess with the intent to purchase less than a specified amount of a controlled substance; authorizing a court to impose a sentence other than the mandatory minimum term of imprisonment and mandatory fine for a person convicted of trafficking if the court makes certain findings on the record; requiring that a custodial interrogation conducted at a place of detention in connection with certain offenses be electronically recorded in its entirety; revising the circumstances under which a wrongfully incarcerated person is eligible for compensation, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice; recommended favorably as a committee substitute by Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

**CS/SB 352 (2R) by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs and Space and Senator Hutson—**

**Unlawful Use of Uniforms, Medals, or Insignia;** Prohibiting certain misrepresentations concerning military service when made for specified purposes, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2020

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs and Space; the Committee on Ethics and Elections reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**SB 374 (2R) by Senator Rouson—**

**Housing Discrimination;** Removing housing discrimination as a cause of action for certain relief and damages stemming from violations of the Florida Civil Rights Act of 1992; revising the conditions under which an aggrieved person may commence a civil action in any appropriate court against a specified respondent to enforce specified rights; authorizing, rather than requiring, a civil action to commence within a specified period after an alleged discriminatory housing practice, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**CS/SB 426 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations, Senator Montford and others—**

**Regional Rural Development Grants;** Specifying that the concept of building the professional capacity of a regional economic development organization includes the hiring of professional staff to perform specified services; providing that matching grants may be used to provide technical assistance to local governments and economic development organizations and to existing and prospective businesses; increasing the amount of funds the Department of Economic Opportunity may expend each fiscal year from the Rural Community Development Revolving Loan Fund for certain purposes; revising the maximum percentage of total infrastructure project costs for which the department may award grants, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism; reported favorably by the Committee on Innovation, Industry, and Technology; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

**SB 486 (2R) by Senator Bradley—**

**Florida Best and Brightest Programs;** Repealing provisions relating to the Florida Best and Brightest Teacher Program and the Florida Best and Brightest Principal Program, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Education; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Education; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

**SB 540 (2R) by Senator Rader and others—**

**Insurance Guaranty Associations;** Authorizing certain guaranty association employees to adjust losses for the Florida Insurance Guaranty Association if certain conditions are met; redefining the term "net direct written premiums" as "direct written premiums" and revising the definition of that term; deleting a calculation of initial estimated assessments levied by the Office of Insurance Regulation on insurers in the Florida Insurance Guaranty Association; deleting a calculation of initial estimated assessments levied by the office on insurers in the Florida Workers' Compensation Insurance Guaranty Association, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

**CS/SB 604 (2R) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Bean—**

**Servicemembers Civil Relief Act;** Revising the definition of the terms "abandoned" or "abandonment"; providing that certain state laws relating to children do not supersede the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act; requiring the Department of Children and Families to ensure that the act is observed in certain cases, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**CS/SB 838 (2R) by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism and Senator Simmons—**

**Business Organizations;** Specifying that certain documents accepted by the Department of State for filing are effective on the date the documents are accepted by the department; revising the required contents of a meeting notice relating to the removal of a director by shareholders; authorizing a domestic corporation to acquire one or more classes or series of shares under certain circumstances; authorizing the department to direct certain interrogatories to certain corporations and to officers or directors of certain corporations, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce and Tourism; the Committee on Judiciary reports the committee substitute favorably; and the Committee on Rules reports the committee substitute favorably*

**SB 1224 (2R) by Senator Simmons and others—**

**Real Estate Conveyances;** Providing that subscribing witnesses are not required to validate certain instruments conveying a leasehold interest in real property, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

**SB 2506 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations (Bradley)—**

**Correctional Medical Authority;** Transferring the State of Florida Correctional Medical Authority from the Executive Office of the Governor to the Department of Health by a type two transfer, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

**SB 7016 (2R) by the Committee on Infrastructure and Security (Lee)—**

**Statewide Office of Resiliency;** Establishing the office within the Executive Office of the Governor; creating the Statewide Sea-Level Rise Task Force within the office; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to contract for specified services, upon request of the task force; requiring the Environmental Regulation Commission to take certain action on the task force's recommendations, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations*

**SB 7022 (2R) by the Committee on Infrastructure and Security (Lee)—**

**OGSR/E-mail Addresses/Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles;** Amending a provision which provides an exemption from public records requirements for certain e-mail addresses collected by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2020

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Rules*

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
