### **SB 312 (2R) by Senator Passidomo—**

**Florida Statutes;** Amending and repealing provisions to conform to the directive of the Legislature in section 9 of chapter 2012-116, Laws of Florida, codified as section 11.242(5)(j), Florida Statutes, to prepare a reviser's bill to omit all statutes and laws, or parts thereof, which grant duplicative, redundant, or unused rulemaking authority, etc. Effective Date: On the 60th day after adjournment sine die of the session of the Legislature in which enacted

### **CS/SB 416 (2R) by the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security, Senator Burgess and others—**

**POW-MIA Vietnam Veterans Bracelet Memorial;** Establishing the POW-MIA Vietnam Veterans Bracelet Memorial; directing the Department of Management Services to designate space for the memorial's construction and placement by a specified date; requiring the department to consider recommendations of, and coordinate with, specified entities regarding the memorial's placement and design, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
