CS/SB 2-D (SO) by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Boyd—

Property Insurance; Creating the Reinsurance to Assist Policyholders program to be administered by the State Board of Administration; requiring certain property insurers to obtain coverage under the program; revising homeowner eligibility criteria for mitigation grants; requiring claimants to establish that property insurers have breached the insurance contract to prevail in certain claims for damages; requiring the Office of Insurance Regulation to aggregate on a statewide basis and make publicly available certain data submitted by insurers and insurer groups, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations

SB 4-D (SO) by Senator Boyd-

Roof Repair, Replacement, and Recovering Requirements;

Providing that the entire roofing system or roof section of certain existing buildings or structures does not have to be repaired, replaced, or recovered in accordance with the Florida Building Code under certain circumstances; requiring the Florida Building Commission to adopt rules and incorporate the rules into the building code; prohibiting local governments from adopting certain administrative or technical amendments to the building code, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law
