

11 Counties must be Split by Population in the State Senate Map




Policy Issues:

- Northwest: No effect.
- Northeast and North Central: Duval and Volusia counties.
- Central: Polk, Orange and Brevard counties.
- Southeast: Palm Beach, Broward and Miami-Dade counties.
- Southwest: Pinellas, Hillsborough and Collier counties.

The City of Jacksonville, with a population of 821,784, is the only city in Florida that must be split by two State Senate districts.








































VTDs in Central Florida with 35% or greater Black VAP












VTDs in Southeast Florida with 35% or greater Hispanic VAP




















Black in Hillsborough, Pinellas, and Manatee Counties
